

## SNOMAD PALACE RULES

2013

The Palace (Cabin, Pavillion, & appurtenances) is for club-related snow machine activities only as per our lease agreement with the Department of Natural Resources. No other uses are allowed unless authorized in writing by Snomads, Inc. Unauthorized use may lead to revocation of membership and forfeiture of membership dues. Unauthorized use includes, but is not limited to: hunting, fishing, trapping, skiing, bicycling, snowshoeing, hiking, or any other use Snomads may deem unacceptable.

Our Palace is available for use to current members and their guests. As such, Snomads expects its users to keep it in a safe and sanitary condition. The following rules are expected of anyone using the Palace:

- 1 - No one 18 years old or under or their guests shall use the Palace without the direct supervision of a responsible adult member.
- 2 - Users are to leave the cabin in the same or better condition in which they found it.
- 3 - No smoking, alcohol consumption, or pets are allowed inside the cabin.
- 4 - All garbage is to be hauled out.
- 5 - Any cut wood used is to be replaced and stacked on the cabin porch. No garbage is to be burned in the wood stove as this attracts unwanted creatures.
- 6 - Club supplies are not for members personal use. Any unopened paper products or non-perishable items may be left behind, if you choose to do so.
- 7 - Cook stove, BBQ grill and propane lights are powered by portable propane tanks. If the fuel runs out, please replace it with another tank. Please let a Snomad know the tank needs replaced.
- 8 - When you leave, please shut off all propane appliances, both at the unit, the valve next to the stove, and at the tanks. Make sure door and windows are completely shut and latched. Ensure that the 5 gallon catch bucket below the sink is empty and ready to catch wastewater.
- 9 - Reservations are only for the upstairs loft area. The downstairs is open to all members at all times. Search & Rescue operations and Snomads Events shall have precedence over any reservation.
